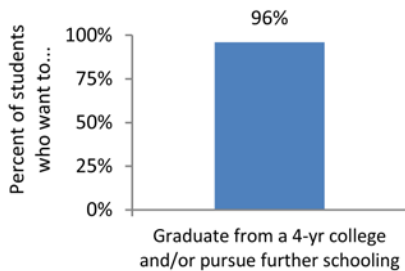

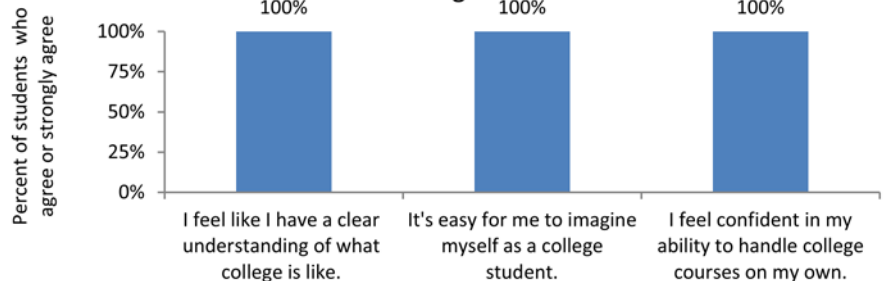

Post High School Aspirations

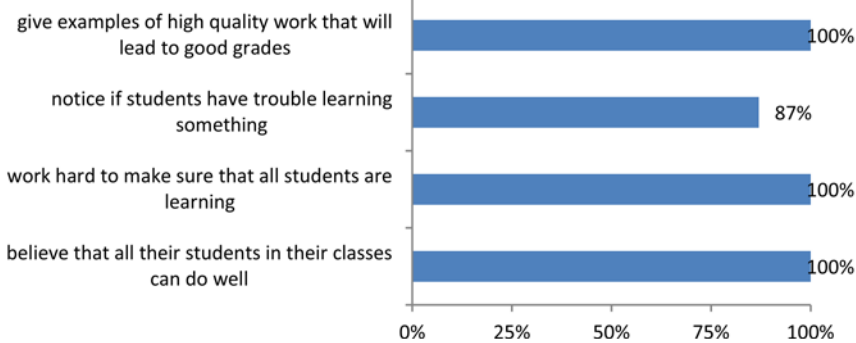


College Readiness

Percent of students who agree or strongly agree that high school teachers...

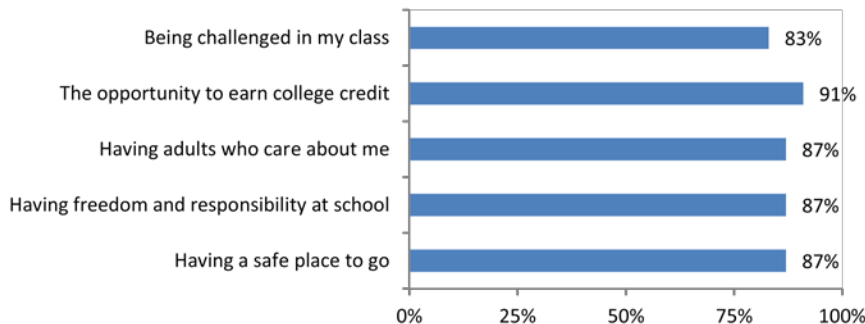


Support from School
