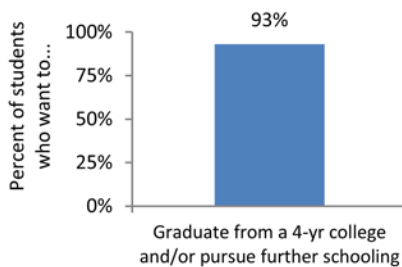
- 404 students enrolled in grades 9-12

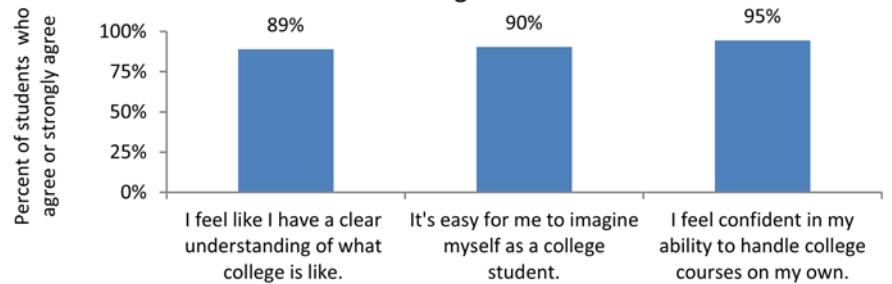

Post High School Aspirations

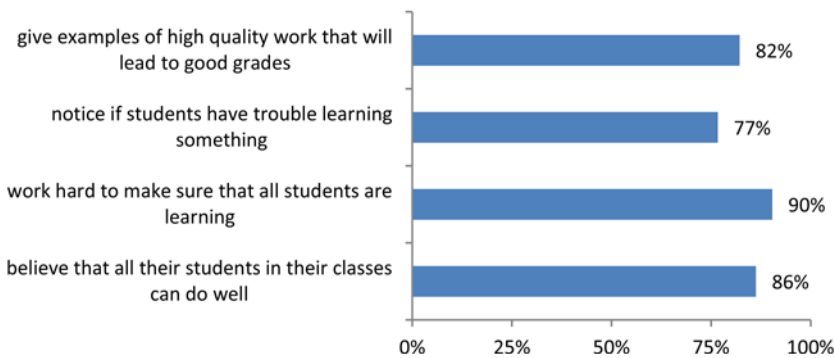


College Readiness
