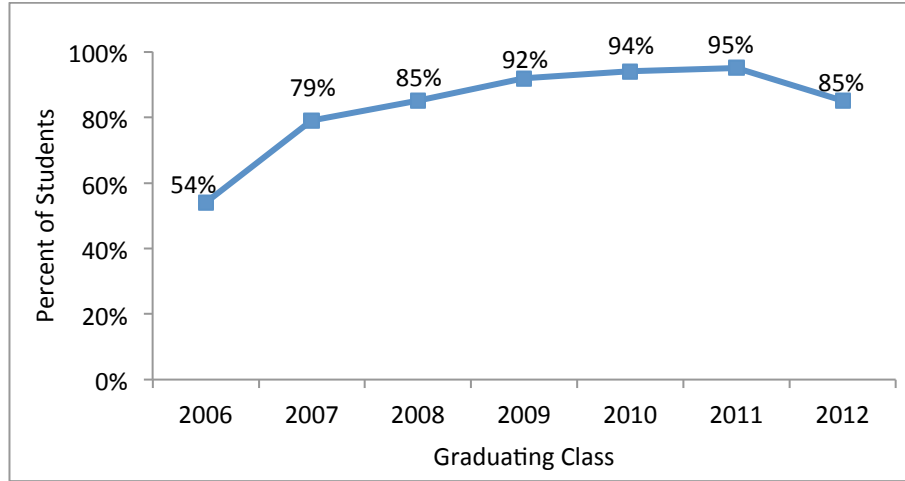


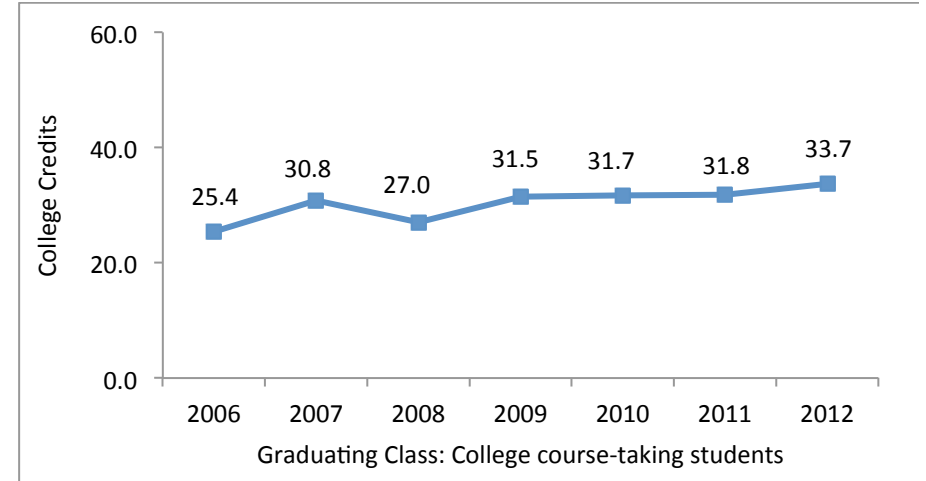

College Course-taking in High School Graduating Classes, 2006-2012

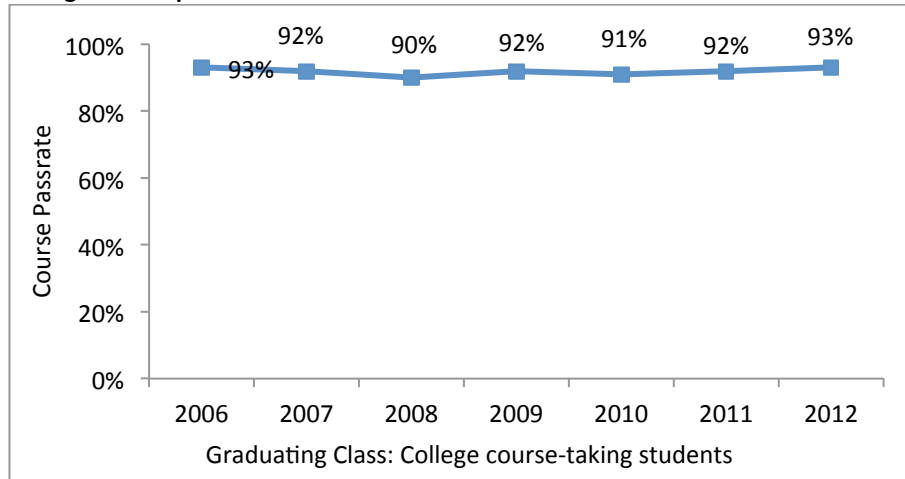
Percent of college course-taking students



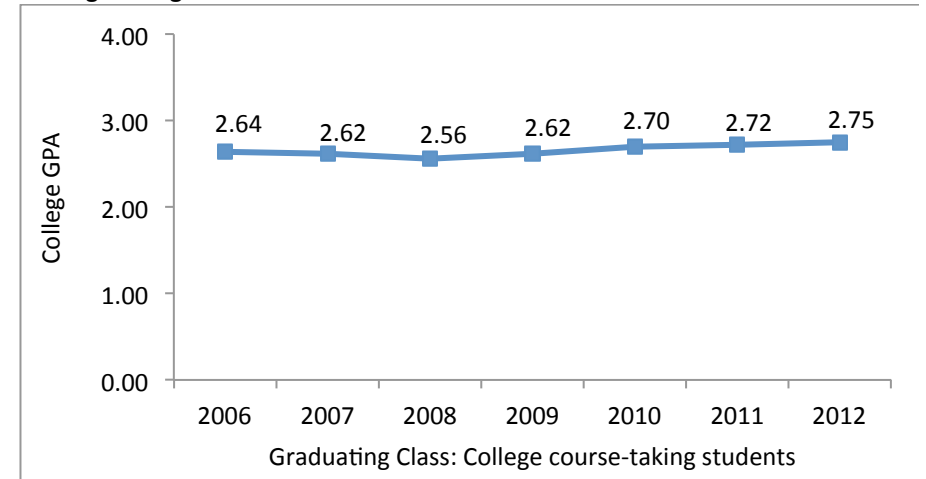
Average number of college credits accumulated

Course passrates are at D grade or higher.

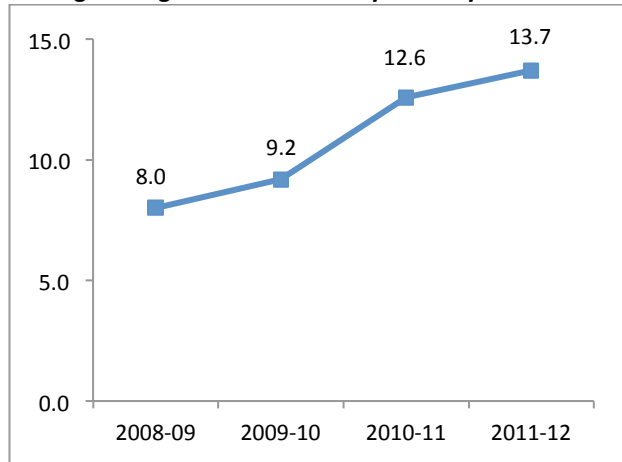

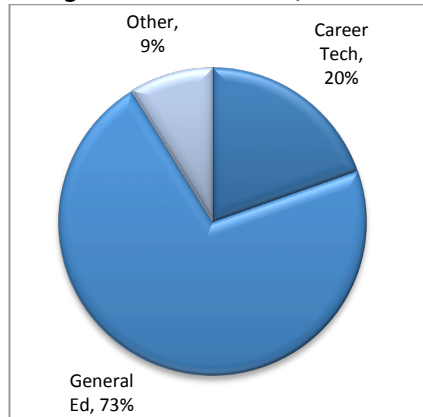

Average college credits earned by school year

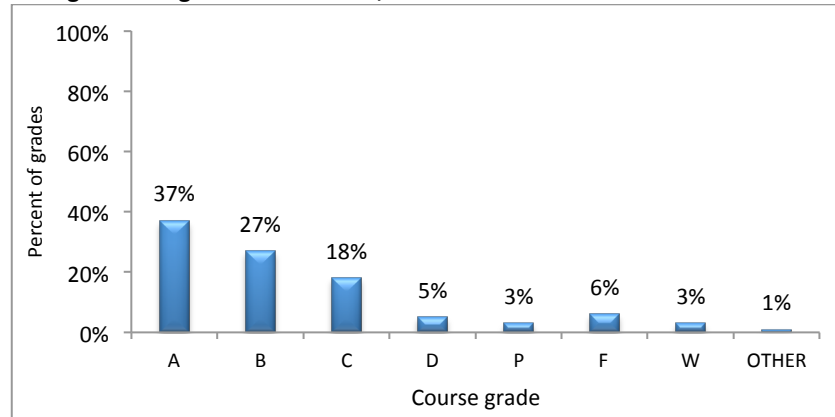

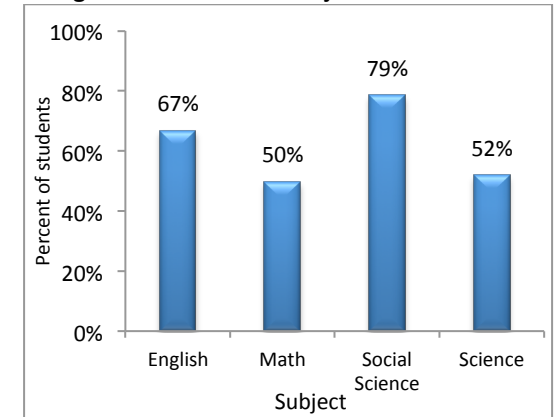
College credit distribution, cumulative
