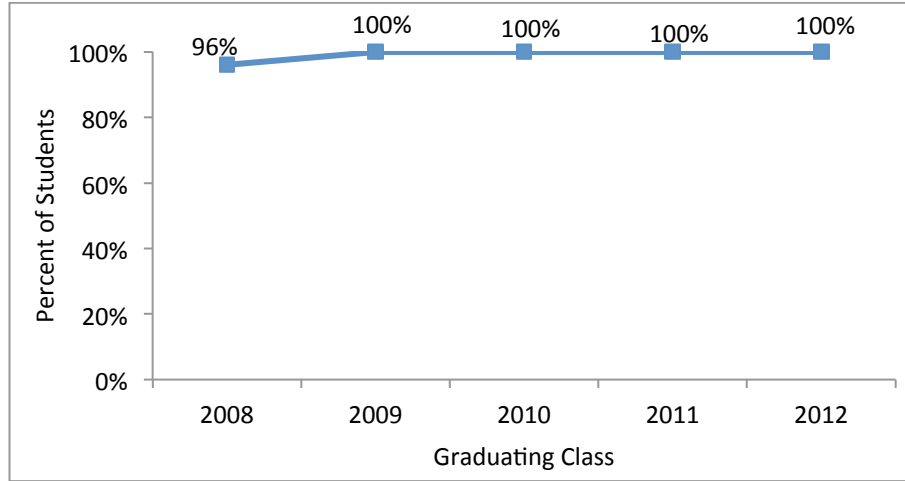


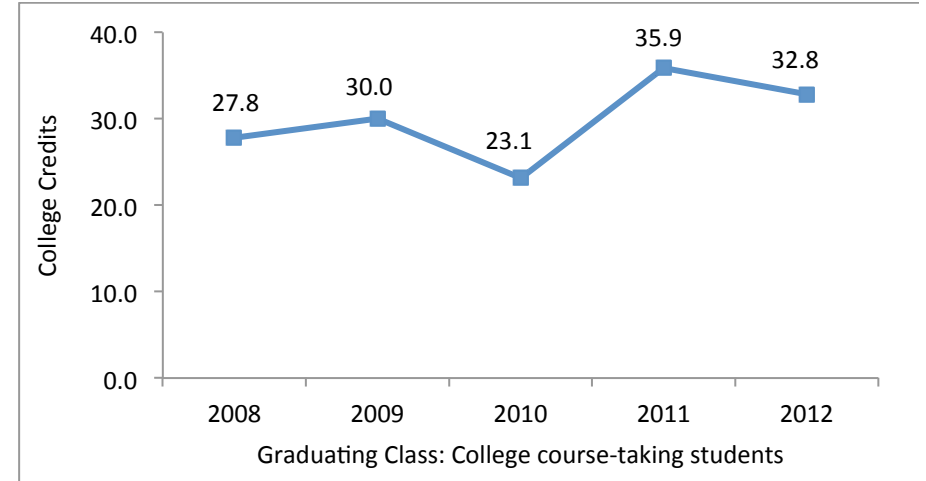

### College Course-taking in High School Graduating Classes, 2008-2012

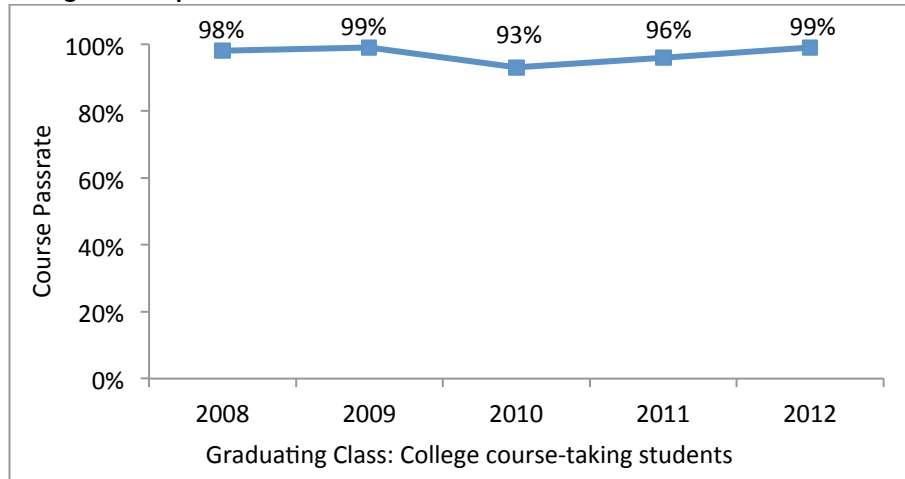
Percent of college course-taking students



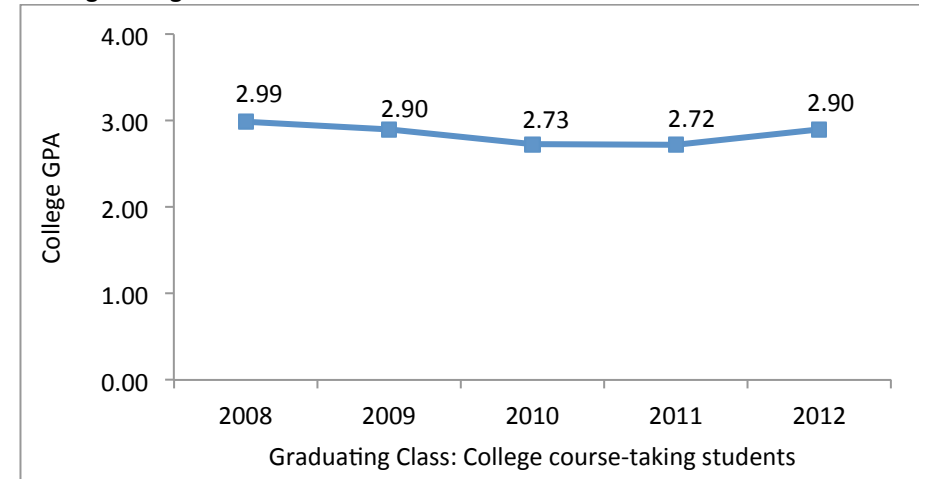
Average number of college credits accumulated

Average college GPA



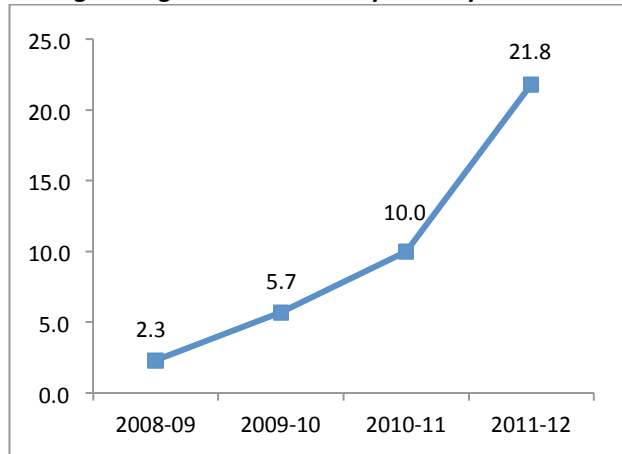

Average college credits earned by school year

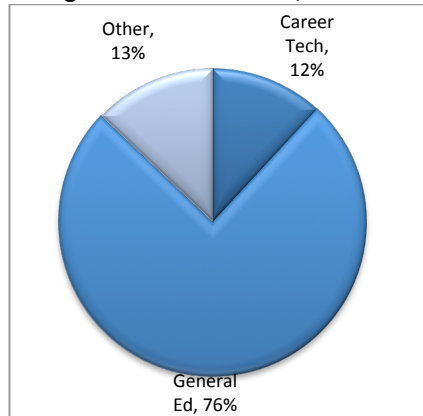

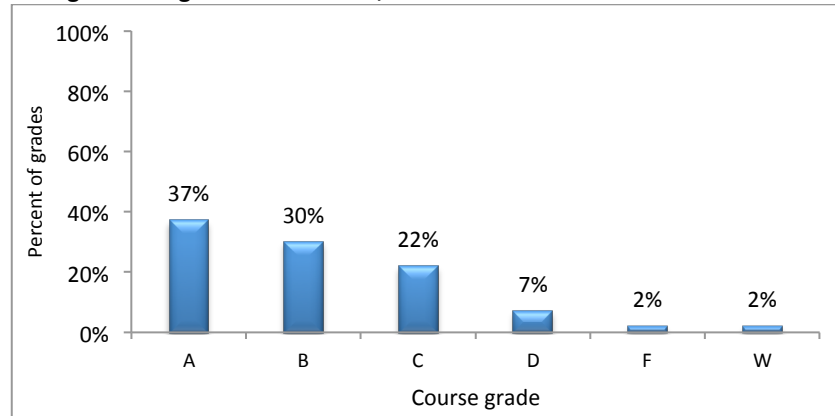

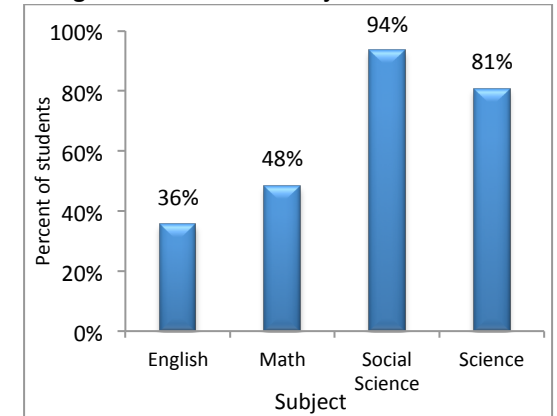
College credit distribution, cumulative
